

A Little Lace Kitchen Cloth

Carol Bristol Designs



Size 7/4.5mm needles
One skein of kitchen cotton

[] brackets-work the stitches inside the brackets for the number of times indicated immediately after the bracket.

SSK-*Slip one st, then slip the next st. Insert left needle into the front loops of the slipped stitches on R needle and knit them together (through the back loops). A left slanted decrease. *Slip the sts as if you were going to purl them, but do not work them.

Sts- stitches **RS**- right side. **YO**-yarn over.

Cast on 41 sts with long tail cast on method (allow about 1 yard for the "tail") or cable cast on method. These methods are described online or in knitting reference books.

Rows 1-5: Knit

Row 6: K4, P33, K4

Row 7: (RS) K6 [K2tog, YO, K1, YO, SSK, K3] three times, then K2tog, YO, K1, YO, SSK, K2, K4.

Row 8: K4, P33, K4

Row 9: K5, *K2tog, YO, K3, YO, SSK, K1, repeat from * to last 4 sts, K4

Row 10: K4, P33, K4

Row 11: K6 [K2tog, YO, K1, YO, SSK, K3] three times, then K2tog, YO, K1, YO, SSK, K2, K4.

Row 12: K4, P33, K4

Row 13: K5, *YO, SSK, K3, K2tog, YO, K1, rep from * to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 14: K4, P33, K4

Row 15: K6, [YO, SSK, K1, K2tog, YO, K3] three times, then YO, SSK, K1, K2tog, YO, K2, K4

Row 16: K4, P33, K4

Row 17: Repeat row 13

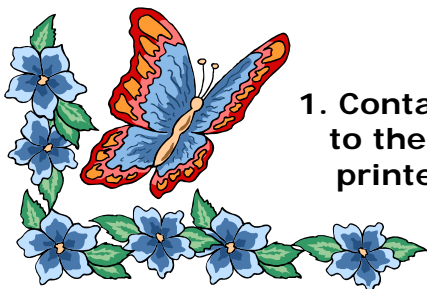
Row 18: K4, P33, K4

Repeat rows 7-18 two more times, then rows 7-12 once more.

Knit 4 rows to form the top border.

Bind off purl-wise. Weave in ends securely on wrong side.

Block and enjoy!



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
