

A Little Lace Kitchen Cloth

Size 7/4.5mm knitting needles
120 yards worsted weight cotton

Cast on 41 sts with long tail cast on method (*allow about 1 yard for the "tail"*) or cable cast on method. These methods are described online or in knitting reference books.

Rows 1-5: Knit all sts

Row 6: K4, p33, k4

Row 7: (RS) K6, [k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3] three times, k2tog, yo, k1 yo, ssk, k6

Row 8: K4, p33, k4

Row 9: K5, *k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4

Row 10: K4, p33, k4

Row 11: K6 [k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3] three times, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k6

Row 12: K4, p33, k4

Row 13: K5, *yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4

Row 14: K4, p33, k4

Row 15: K6, [yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k3] three times, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k6

Row 16: K4, p33, k4

Row 17: K5, *yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4

Row 18: K4, p33, k4

Rows 19-42: rep rows 7-18 twice more.

Row 43-48: rep rows 7-12 once more.

Rows 49-52: Knit all sts

Bind off purl-wise. Weave in ends securely on wrong side.

Block and enjoy!



Abbreviations

[] brackets-work the sts inside the brackets for the number of times indicated immediately after the bracket.

LH ndl-left hand needle

RH ndl- right hand needle

Rep: repeat

RS- right side.

SSK-Slip first st knitwise, then slip the next st, purlwise. Insert LH ndl into the front loops of the slipped stitches on RH ndl and knit them together (through the back loops).
A left slanted decrease.

Sts- stitches

YO-yarn over
