



Peas in Cream

85 yards worsted weight cotton
5/ 3.75mm knitting needles

Cast on 48 sts using your favorite method.

Rows 1-5: Knit all stitches

Row 6: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5

Row 7: K7, yo, k2tog, k30, skp, yo, k7.

Row 8: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5

Row 9: K7, yo, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1, yo, k9, k2tog, k1, yo, k9, skp, yo, k7

Row 10: K5, p14, yo, p1, p2tog, p9, yo, p1, p2tog, p9, k5

Row 11: K7, yo, k2tog, k4 [k2tog, k1, yo, k9] twice, k2, skp, yo, k7

Row 12: K5, p16, yo, p1, p2tog, p9, yo, p1, p2tog, p7, k5

Row 13: K7, yo, k2tog, k30, skp, yo, k7

Row 14: K5, p to last 5 sts, k5

Row 15: K7, yo, k2tog, k9, yo, k1, skp, k9, yo, k1, skp, k6, skp, yo, k7

Row 16: K5, p9, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p9, p2tog tbl, p1, yo, p14, k5

Row 17: K7, yo, k2tog, k2, [k9, yo, k1, skp] twice, k4, skp, yo, k7

Row 18: K5, P7, P2tog-tbl, P1, YO, P9, P2tog-tbl, P1, YO, P16, K5

Rows 19-54: repeat rows 7-18 three more times.

Rows 55- 62: repeat rows 7-14 once more.

Row 63: repeat row 7 once more.

Rows 64-66: Knit all stitches

Bind-off all stitches, knit-wise.

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Sugar n' Cream Lime Stripes, 9 ½" wide by 9 ¾" tall



Abbreviations

K2tog: Knit 2 sts together as one.

P2tog-tbl: Purl 2 sts together as one, through the back loop. With yarn in front and from left to right, insert the right needle tip in the 2nd st through to the 1st stitch. Bring yarn around needle and purl them together.

SKP: Slip the next st as if to knit without working the st, knit the next st, with left needle point pick up the slipped st and pass it over the knitted st, dripping it off the right needle.

St-stitch

YO: Before a knit stitch-wrap working yarn around the right needle by bringing it from the back, under the right needle, wrapping over the top of the right needle to return it to the back position.

YO: Before a purl stitch- work as YO above, but continue to bring the yarn from the back position under right needle **again** to have it in the front ready to purl the next st. You will still have increased a stitch.
